Prayer is Vital to Our Nation

Pray for Revival.

“Revival converts tend to be lasting converts. 2nd Chronicles 7:14 *“If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.”*
